Catherine Ruble Tull died peacefully Monday, March 11, at Seton Hospital, surrounded by her husband and four children. The daughter of Charles B. and Elsie Leona Davis Ruble, she was born

on November 20, 1928, and raised on a dairy farm outside of Decatur, Illinois. She attended business school, met her husband of sixty years at the University of Illinois, and has lived in Austin since 1961.
