Annette Cooke Stokes passed away peacefully at the age of 84 on December 30, 2020 from heart complications and pneumonia (not Cov-19). She was surrounded by her daughters and loving husband of 61 years. She leaves a legacy of loving her family and serving her community and her God.

Annette was born August 26, 1936 in Spartanburg County, SC. She completed Greer (SC) High School and graduated Magna Cum Laude from Coker College, Hartsville, SC. She was tireless in raising money for their scholarship program for young women to attend college.
